Unattended Children Policy

Children under the age of 8 may not be left unattended in the library.

Unattended is defined to mean a parent, guardian, or responsible adult over the age of 17, is not directly in charge of a child under the age of 8; or a child over the age of 8 is left in the library at closing time.

Children under the age of 8 must be with their parent, or responsible adult, at all times while in the library.

If staff suspects a child is unattended, the following procedure shall be followed:

- 1. An in-charge staff person will try to identify and locate the child's parent or responsible adult within the library building and inform them of this policy.
- 2. If the parent or responsible adult is not found in the building, an in-charge staff person shall stay with the child and try to locate the parent or responsible adult by patron records, or other means available.
- 3. If the parent or responsible adult is located elsewhere, the in-charge staff person will explain this policy, and they will be asked to pick-up their child immediately. If the child is not picked-up within 15 minutes, the police will be called.
- 4. If a parent or responsible adult cannot be located, the in-charge staff person will call the police and stay with the child until the police arrive.
